ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Waikhom Mani Girls' College, formerly known as Thoubal Girls' College was established in the year 1980 at Thoubal Okram with great enthusiasm of the local people and Educationists for promotion women's Higher Education in the rural areas where the women literacy rate was very low in comparison to those of urban areas. It is the only Girls' College in Thoubal District that promotes women education in rural area up to the degree level.

The Manipur University granted permanent affiliation up to degree level (Arts and Science) in the year 1997. The college was recognized under section 2 (f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956 in the year 1998. The college was Accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore with CGPA 2.22 on Four point Scale at "B" Grade. The college was granted Government Aided Status in the year 2011 and converted into a full flaged Government College on 21st August, 2019.

The beautiful campus of the college is spread in two places. The main campus is at Thoubal Okram and there is a satellite campus at Samu Manbi Ching,

Thoubal Khunou. Administrative Block, Library Building, Spacious Class rooms with latest Smart Class Equipment and Laboratories, Basket Ball Court, Girls' Hostel, College Canteen, Indoor stadium, Computer Centre with good number of Computers, Well developed Vocational Work Sheds, Well equipped Research Laboratory i.e. Biotech Hub contribute to the all round development of the students.

The college has earned an evitable reputation in teaching and research in the Sciences as well as in Social Sciences. In keeping with the UGC policy of vocationalization of education, the college has opened Five Career Oreinted Courses and 6 skill development coureses under B. Voc and Community College Scheme.

Students of the college have also excellent in Extra-curricular activities winning medals in sports and other cultural competitions at the inter college level, state level and national level. Co-curricular activities include the National Service Scheme (NSS) and the National Cadet Corps (NCC) and Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA).

GRADUATION COURSES

The duration of Graduation courses is 3 years (6 semesters), under the new scheme of Manipur University. Each candidate has to offer 3 Elective Subjects and a General English or MIL (Manipuri) in the 1st and 2nd Semester and there will be a paper on the "Regional Development in the Northeast" for 3rd Semester and "Environmental Studies" in the 4th Semester. From the 5th Semester onwards a student shall choose any one of the Elective Subjects offered in the previous semesters as honours subject.

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HOW TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION

A duly filled application form along with the relevant documents should be submitted to the college admission counter on or before the last date of form submission as notified by the college.

Incomplete application forms shall be rejected. Under no circumstances forms shall be received after the last date.

DOCUMENTS TO BE ENCLOSED

- i) Two Passport Size and One stamp size copies of applicant's recent photograph
- ii) Three photo copies of Mark Sheets, Provisional Certificates and Admit Cards of HSLC and Hr. Sec. Examination for 1st Semester students (Original Certificates, Mark Sheets, Admit Cards should be produced when demanded).
- iii) OBC/SC/ST/PWD Certificates should be enclosed in case of OBC/SC/ST/PWD candidate.
- iv) Migration certificate in original (in case of students from other Board/University)
- v) One copy of Passport size photography of the Father/Mother/Guardian duly attested by a Gazetted Officer.

vi) Transfer certificate for students transferred from other Board/University.

vii) Photo copy of Aadhar Card.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Selection of students in different courses will be strictly base on the merit of the qualifying Examinations.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND RULES

Candidates seeking admission shall be bounded by the rules and regulations of the college.

- i) Eligibility criteria shall be determined by the admission committee of the college. The decision of the committee will be final.
- ii) Public Examinations of Board/Council and University will be recognized by the college admission committee.
- iii) Candidates should produce the original mark sheets/documents etc. at the time of reporting for admission.

She will not be allowed to complete the admission formalities or in case already admitted, her admission may be cancelled.
