Full papers of accepted abstracts may be submitted on or before 25th October, 2023. Both the abstract and the full paper should be sent by e-mail to semiqacwmgc@gmail.com in MS word format only. Selected papers presented during the seminar will be published as an edited book with ISBN Number. However, the decision of the Jury will be final for selection of the papers to be published.
